

DIRECTIONS TO GALLATIN CIVIC CENTER

FROM THE EAST:

Take I-40 to the Highway 109 Exit (Exit 232) and head towards Gallatin. Take a left at the stop light by the Golden Gallon (note that this is still Highway 109) This will be 12.3 miles from I-40. Go 2.6 miles on Highway 109 to the Gallatin exit (North) and merge onto Gallatin Rd. You will travel through the town of Gallatin until the road merges from a 4 lane to a 2 lane. You will take a left onto Albert Gallatin Rd. (Route 174) by Sumner Memorial Gardens. The Civic Center will be about ½ mile on the right.

FROM WEST:

Take I-65 (or Briley Parkway around the city & merge onto I-65) to the Vietnam Veterans Blvd Exit (number 95). Stay on Vietnam Veterans which will dead end into Highway 31E or Gallatin Road. Follow Gallatin Road into Gallatin. You will travel through the town of Gallatin until the road merges from a 4 lane to a 2 lane. You will take a left onto Albert Gallatin Rd. (Route 174) by Sumner Memorial Gardens. The Civic Center will be about ½ mile on the right.

FROM SOUTH:

Take 840 to I-40 to the Highway 109 Exit (Exit 232) and head towards Gallatin. Take a left at the stop light by the Golden Gallon (note that this is still Highway 109) This will be 12.3 miles from I-40.
